ABOUT LAKE MARTIN



“TREASURED ALABAMA LAKE” - This distinction is awarded to lakes that meet quality standards for cleanliness and nutrient enrichment, and Lake Martin was the first Alabama lake to receive this designation. Located in Tallapoosa County, Elmore County, and Coosa County of Alabama, Lake Martin is a beautiful 44,000 acre lake with over 750 miles of wooded shoreline.

Lake Martin was formed after the completion in 1926 of the Martin Dam which is used to generate hydro-electric power for Alabama Power Company. Today it is one of the largest artificial lakes in the United States. A popular recreational destination for water sports, fishing, camping, hiking and golfing, Lake Martin's shorelines are dotted with waterfront neighborhoods and homes, from cozy cabins and condominiums to grand houses. Nearby cities include Alexander City and Dadeville.

From kayaking to wakeboarding, cruising to camping, Lake Martin offers endless opportunities for recreation and relaxation. Pull up and enjoy small islands and beaches, or visit landmarks including Wind Creek State Park, Children's Harbor, D.A.R.E. Park, Martin Dam, and Lake Martin Amphitheater. Climb Smith Mountain Fire Tower, hike the Cherokee Ridge Alpine Trail, visit Chimney Rock, Goat Island and Peanut Point. Enjoy a fireworks show, participate in a fishing tournament, dine at one of the many waterfront and water-access restaurants, or worship at one of the waterfront open air churches. Lake Martin truly promises something for everyone.
