We are asking **every** HOBO, all family members, their friends, neighbors and everyone who loves Lake Martin to each file their comments with **FERC** before August 13. Every individual who enjoys Lake Martin is a stakeholder in this relicensing.

HOBOS support Alabama Power's request to raise the winter pool level three feet, and extend the summer pool to October 15.

- Raising the winter pool by 3 feet will give more time to use the lake.
- Extending the summer pool until October 15 will extend full use of the lake during the best boating season of the year. As the lake goes down, submerged hazards pop up.
- Higher water levels have a positive economic impact
- APCo studies have proven that downstream flooding is not an issue during the changes in Lake operating schedule.
